## Greats of Sport and Wine

### DAY 1

Book the *Adelaide Oval Legends Tour* for a starting time of 9.00am. The tour takes guests behind the scenes for an in-depth insight into the life and times of cricket's greatest batsman, Sir Donald Bradman, with a curated tour through Sir Donald's private and personal collection. Delve into the controversy of the 1930's Bodyline series in the **Bodyline Museum** then take your seat in the player's viewing room, where the greats prepared to bat and walk the path of champions. Finally meet the **Adelaide Oval's** Senior Groundsman for a one-on-one talk and create your own surname plate to display on the century old scoreboard – an honour bestowed on very few.

Take a taxi over to **Penfolds McGill Estate**, just 15 minutes from the Adelaide CBD. **Penfolds** is home to the Bradman of Australian wine – Penfolds Grange. Have a casual lunch at **Magill Estate Kitchen** overlooking the historic **Penfolds** vines and Adelaide city. Taste the **Penfolds** range in the cellar door in the afternoon or book ahead for a winery experience, tour or degustation dinner at the exclusive **Magill Estate Restaurant**.

### DAY 2

Spend the day exploring the **McLaren Vale** wine region, just 45 minutes from Adelaide. Book a driver, a hire car or a day trip tour from Adelaide. The whole region is a beautiful carpet of undulating vineyards stretching to meet the sea. Don't miss **d'Arenberg**, **Wirra Wirra** and **Gemtree**, three heroes of Australian Shiraz and red wine blend production. **Wirra Wirra** and **Gemtree** have informal dining options, focused on platters of local produce to share, while **d'Arenberg** has both informal dining and the recently-opened **Cube Restaurant**, worth booking ahead to experience the luxury degustation.

### DAY 3

Head to the **Adelaide Central Market**, one of the largest undercover fresh markets in the southern hemisphere, buzzing with life and colour all year round, not to mention great coffee and breakfast options and endless fresh produce.

Take the 20-minute stroll to the **Botanic Gardens of South Australia** to wander among thousands of species of roses and enjoy lunch at the restaurant overlooking the Main Lake or coffee and a snack at the café.
